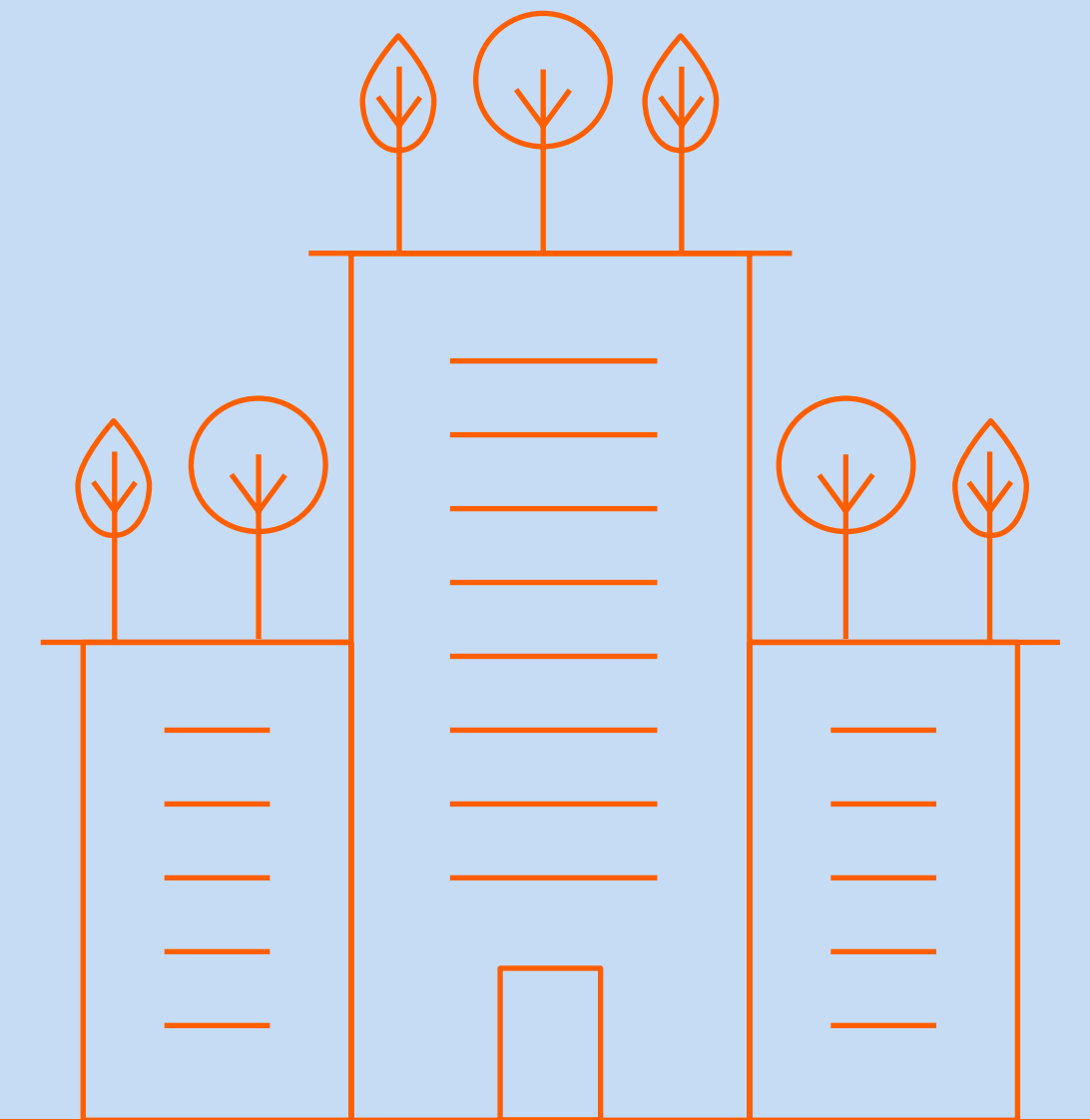
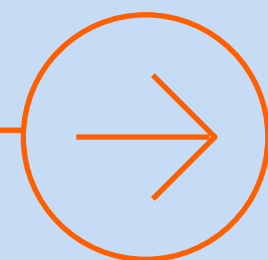


Energy Savings Opportunity Scheme

The Energy Savings Opportunity Scheme (ESOS) is a mandatory energy assessment scheme enforced by the Environment Agency.

Navigating its complexities can feel daunting, especially with the additional requirements introduced by Phase 3 and 4.

How to comply with ESOS

1. Calculate and submit

- Calculate your total energy consumption
- Identify your areas of significant energy consumption
- Complete the required audits for one year's consumption, under the direction of a lead assessor
- Submit your ESOS notification of compliance to the Environment Agency
- Keep records of compliance in an evidence pack

2. Complete an action plan

Following submission of the compliance notification, you must produce an action plan outlining:

- What you intend to do to reduce energy consumption
- When you intend to do it
- Whether it was recommended through your ESOS assessment
- What energy savings you expect to achieve over the four-year period covered by the action plan
- How you estimated these savings

3. Complete an annual progress update

An annual progress update against your action plan commitments in the two subsequent years, must be provided. This encourages you to take the energy saving actions specified in your plan:

- The deadline for submission is 12 months after the action plan deadline, and then 12 months after the submission deadline for the first progress update
- For the third compliance period, the deadlines are 5 December 2025 and 5 December 2026
- Each progress update relates to the 12-month period preceding the deadline

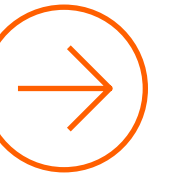

ISO 50001 can be a route to ESOS compliance

This voluntary international standard applies to organisations of any size and provides requirements for establishing, managing and improving energy consumption and efficiency. We guide organisations through the entire process using a practical and attainable approach to achieve certification.

Avoid fines and safeguard your reputation

Penalties for failing to comply fully, or for false or misleading statements range between £5,000 and £90,000. Penalised organisations have been publicly named, risking in-market reputation.



For the current reporting phase, 6th December 2023 – 5th December 2027 (ESOS Phase 4), you will need to comply if either of the following applies:
