

Its aim is to promote energy efficiency within organisations and thereby reduce carbon emissions, supporting the UK's commitment to environmental targets. The legislation introduces mandatory carbon and energy reporting for a larger number of organisations than ever before.

Streamlined Energy and Carbon Reporting (SECR)

Who needs to comply with the SECR framework?

There are three groups of businesses impacted by the new regulations. Companies that fall within the following definitions must comply, unless they meet certain exemption criteria:

- 1 Quoted companies of any size that are already obliged to report under mandatory greenhouse gas reporting regulations.
- 2 Unquoted companies incorporated in the UK that meet the definition of 'large' under the Companies Act 2006 will have new reporting obligations. This applies to registered and unregistered companies.
- 'Large' Limited Liability Partnerships (LLPs) will be required to prepare and file an 'Energy and Carbon Report'.

What's 'large'?

Unquoted companies or LLPs are deemed to be 'large' if they **meet at least two** of the following three criteria in a reporting year:

A balance sheet of

£18 million +




