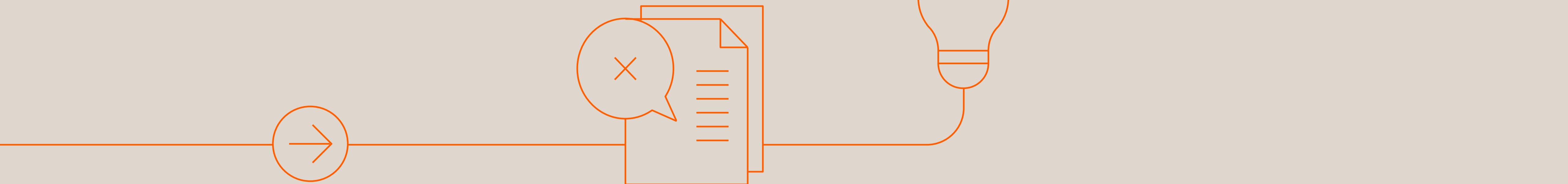


P442 Licence Exempt Supply

**Lower electricity costs by
accessing half-hourly matched
renewable power from approved
independent generators.**

P442 is a market framework that makes it simpler for renewable generators to supply electricity directly to organisations without operating under a full supply licence.

P442 enables eligible renewable power to bypass certain non-energy charges, allowing the financial benefits of that power to be passed through to you.

This means you benefit from lower electricity costs through a transparent process that ensures a fair share of benefits.

How does it work?

Zenergi has partnered with a select number of approved suppliers that analyse your half-hourly data to identify a match between when your organisation uses electricity and a generator generates power. When a half-hourly match is identified, the 'linked' generation is exempt from certain non-commodity charges. These savings are split between you, the generator and the supplier.

What can you save?

Your linked renewable power avoids key non-commodity charges, delivering savings of around 5–6 p/kWh on the portion of electricity matched to licence-exempt generation.

One client saved over £2,000 per month, adding up to more than £30,000 per year, compared with their next-best traditional energy contract.

P442 in practice

- Small-scale generation (<5MW) is treated as 'licence exempt' which means the generators are excluded from paying licenced non-commodity charges, such as Contracts for Difference (CfD), Feed-in Tariff (FiT), Renewables Obligation (RO), and Capacity Market (CM)
- A modification (P442) implemented in the electricity code has made the process of managing exempt supply much simpler
- Under the P442 framework, renewable generation can be allocated to an eligible organisation
- When that allocation is approved, generators and organisations operate within a formal P442 scheme and certain non-commodity costs are reduced on the portion of electricity linked to that generator

The result is reduced charges for the organisation on the eligible volume and improved value for the generator on their output.



P442 Licence Exempt Supply



Key features

- Available to all half-hourly customers, no minimum threshold applies
- Only available on fixed price contracts
- Not available to organisations that receive levy discounts or exemptions via the Energy Intensive Industries (EII) or Climate Change Agreements (CCA) schemes
- Not available on non-half hourly contracts



Key benefits

- Avoid certain non-commodity charges when buying from local, exempt suppliers
- Verify that your energy consumption aligns precisely with renewable generation periods through “timestamped” or “time-matched” supply
- Simplifies the process for smaller generators such as sub-5MW hydro or solar) to sell directly to local users, fostering a more sustainable and decentralised energy system

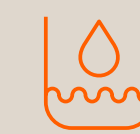
